Pool Rules and Regulations

Open Dates: Memorial Day through Labor Day

Hours: ~~9:00~~ a.m -10:00 p.m. Saturday - Sunday

Note: All RULES or NOTES in *ITALICS* are Cobb County Board of Health Regulations and may not be altered by the Homeowner's Association.

- **There is no lifeguard on duty. Swim at your own risk!!!**
- *The emergency phone is located in the pavilion between the men's and women's bathroom.*
- *bathroom. A first aid kit is located in the women's bathrooms.*
- *A telephone may be found on the wall of the pavilion between the men's and women's bathrooms.*
- *A drinking fountain may be found on the wall of the pavilion next to the men's bathroom*

Rules and Regulations:

- *No person suffering from a communicable disease transmissible via water shall use the pool.*
- **Dogs and other pets shall not be permitted in the swimming pool or on the pool premises.**
- *Bathers are required to take a cleansing shower before entering the pool.*
- **Eating and drinking are not permitted within the pool and deck enclosure.**
Food and beverages are permitted in the visitor/spectator area (by the picnic tables) only when served in non-breakable containers.
- There should be no solo swimming.
- **NO children under the age of 14 may use the pool unless accompanied by an adult.**
- There should be no running, boisterousness, or play in pool area.
- **No diving allowed.**
- No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
- **Pool and common grounds may only be used by Winterchase residents who are in good standing (i.e., have paid their yearly dues, special appropriations and fines in full).**
- Guests are permitted **ONLY** when accompanied by a Winterchase resident in good standing.
- **If you are a Winterchase resident who is NOT in good standing, you may NOT use the pool as a guest of a Winterchase resident.**
- Exclusive use of pool for group parties is not permitted.
- **Food attracts ants. Please keep the area free of crumbs and dispose of all trash in a proper container.**
- Smoking is NOT permitted in pool area.
- **Use of a radio, CD or tape player is only permitted with earphones. You may want to listen to music, but the other guests at the pool may not.**
- Swim diapers must be used by all children and infants who are not toilet trained. The changing of diapers is not permitted in the pool area due to possible E. coli bacterial contamination and a baby changing station can be found in the women's bathroom. IF an accident occurs, it is the responsibility of the parent to contact a member of the HOA board

immediately. It will be necessary for everyone to leave the pool so it may be chemically treated.

Tips for Everyone

- Do not enter the water if you have diarrhea.
- Do not swallow the water.
- Do wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water after a visit to the bathroom.

Tips for Parents

- Take your child to the toilet for bathroom breaks often.
- Wash you child thoroughly with soap and water before swimming.
- Do not count on swim diapers or pants to keep fecal matter from leaking in the water.
- Do not allow your child to chew gum or eat while swimming or playing in the water to prevent choking.

NOTE: Article II, Section 1(b) of the Covenants for the Winterchase Subdivision state that the right of a resident to vote as well as use the recreational facilities can be suspended for up to 60 days for any infraction of the rules and regulations. Our policy is a warning for first violation (if minor) and suspension for repeat offenders. Activities that endanger the health and welfare of residents will not be tolerated.
